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PRAC ID Application – SLP Referrals to Psychiatrists

As of October 4, 2004, registered speech-language pathologists (SLPs), who have a Practitioner Identification Number (PRAC ID), may refer clients directly to psychiatrists for consultations in the form of a verbal or written communication (fax, email, and letter).

SLPs who are registered with ACSLPA and working in Alberta are eligible for a PRAC ID. To obtain a PRAC ID to allow direct referral of clients to a psychiatrist, the following steps are required:

Register with Alberta Health

1. Complete the [Referral Provider Information Form](#).
2. Submit the completed/signed form and a copy of your Practice Permit (access the [ACSLPA online registration system](#) to print) to Alberta Health via email to health.pracforms@gov.ab.ca or send to the address below:

SLPs are responsible for providing their PRAC ID to psychiatrists when a referral occurs.
